The Senate met pursuant to adjournment.

Messrs. White and Wynne, by permission, recorded their votes in favor of the 15th amendment.

Mr. Smith, from the committee on Propositions and Grievances, reported, recommending the indefinite postponement of bill to annex certain counties of Virginia; and favorably on bill for the relief of Jesse Furner, and favorably, with certain amendments, on bill authorizing county commissioners to investigate the official conduct of county officers.

Mr. Barrow, from the committee on the Judiciary, reported adversely on bill to repeal an act passed in 1858-9 relative to Roanoke Canal.

Mr. Beeman, from committee on Finance, reported adversely on bill to lay off a new county to be called Rocky Mount.

Mr. Forkner, from the special committee to which was referred the language of the Senators from Carteret and Jackson, reported a preamble and resolutions censuring
