TAKE NOTICE

1. In May, 1988, the Rocky Mount City Board of Education filed a lawsuit against the North Carolina State of Education seeking to enforce the law which requires that the State of North Carolina pay for the education of all children who are enrolled in the State of North Carolina. The lawsuit was filed in the District Court of the State of North Carolina in the County of Currituck, North Carolina, and the parties to the lawsuit are the Rocky Mount City Board of Education and the State of North Carolina.

2. The parties to the lawsuit have agreed upon a settlement of the suit and the terms of the settlement are set forth in the attached proposed decree, which is subject to the approval of the court. The court will enter its order approving the settlement and the proposed decree if the court is satisfied that the settlement is in the best interests of the parties and that the proposed decree is fair and equitable.

3. The settlement of this lawsuit is contingent upon the passage of Senate Bill 200 by the North Carolina General Assembly. The City of Rocky Mount and the City of Southport are parties to this lawsuit, and the settlement of this lawsuit will affect the operations of the City of Rocky Mount and the City of Southport.
